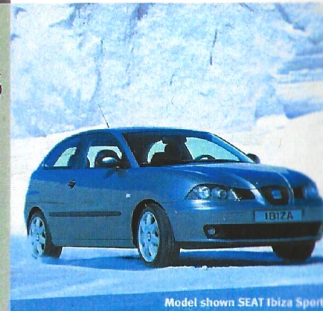

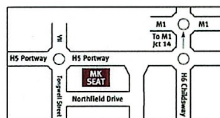

Last season saw the Raiders lose out in the LEAGUE and CHAMPIONSHIP titles to Invicta. However, they managed to reverse those fortunes by winning the Challenge Cup in the final game of the season in Invicta. Romford have a strong squad of players and will play a hard gritty type of style which I am sure will upset a few teams and referees alike.

ONES TO WATCH:

Jason Rushden #91 Forward- Import

Much travelled Jason has a long pedigree in North American hockey with career stats of 138 goals and over 150 assists. The 27 year old has also tallied 1467 penalty minutes. Jason had a handful of games in the 'A' (AHL) and the 'I' (IHL) so he has a quality background, can play right wing or centre and has put the puck away wherever he's played. Last season he scored 35 goals and 35 assists in only 22 games, definitely one to watch.

Kevin Solari #17 Forward- Import

The 28 year old winger has appeared for a variety of clubs in the CoHL, UHL, WPHL and WHL all quality professional leagues. The common thread is points at every club...and penalty minutes. Solari has racked up career stats of 85 goals, 115 assists and 1120 penalty minutes.

Phil Lee #44 Defence- British

Phil 'Leapy' Lee joins Romford from Solihull, where he was last season's player/coach. Phil is a solid defenceman who earned the man of the match award on two occasions when the Barons visited Rom Valley Way last season. Despite his age, Phil is still one of the best British defencemen around.

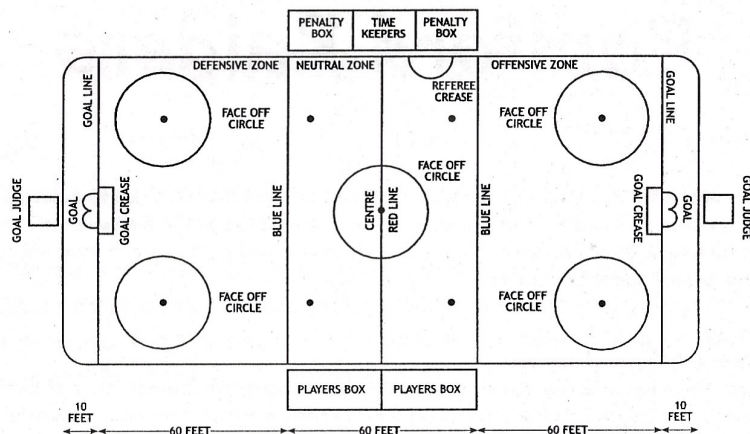
Jamie Randall #19 Forward- British

Brother of Lightning's Greg Randall, Jamie joined the Raiders from Chelmsford for the 2001-2002 season, and has also played for Invicta. He is widely regarded as one of the best defence forwards in the league. A superb debut season at Romford saw Jamie win the coaches player of the year along with the supporters player of the year and was one of the first players to resign for the new season.

Rob Douglas #18 Forward -Import

A late addition to the Raiders roster, Douglas was courted by the team during the 2000/2001 season, but then he decided to play for Basingstoke Bison. A 5' 10", 190lb lefty, 26 year-old Douglas is a natural centre and was top scorer for his University team in the NCAA, before going on to play pro hockey with the Anchorage Aces in the WCHL under former Swindon, and Paisley Pirates coach Stirling Wright.

THE ARENA



Game Officials

The referee controls the game. He calls all the penalties and must decide the legality of goals, though sometimes he will call time and ask his linesmen for an opinion before he makes the final decision. The duty of the linesmen is to determine offside and icing. They drop the puck for face offs. They chase the puck after stoppage of play.

Object of the Game

The object is to score goals by putting the puck in the other team's goal whilst making sure that the other team don't do the same to you. Players can hit it in with a stick or deflect it off another player including the goalie. It's not illegal to kick it across the line, push it across the line or volley it in, from a high stick.

Rules of the Game

There are only **two** basic rules in ice hockey:

Off Side: When an attacking player crosses the defending team's blue line before the puck he is Off Side. Play is halted and a face-off is held on the nearest spot in the neutral zone.

Icing: If a defending player shoots the puck from his own half past the opposing team's goal line and the puck is next touched by an opposing player, icing is called. Play is halted and the puck is returned to the place where the pass originated.

Duration

The senior game consists of three periods of twenty minutes each. The clock stops with the action.

Scoring

A goal is legal if all of the puck crosses all of the goal-line.

EXCEPTIONS ARE:-

It's not legal however if there is an attacking player in the goal crease who is currently not held by a defender whilst his team mates score.

It is legal to score by kicking providing the puck is deflected off a defenders stick before entering the goal.

No more than two assists can be credited on any goal and these go to the players who handle the puck immediately preceding the goal.

One of the event coordinators said, "The event had an electric atmosphere and every game was played with great enthusiasm building up to a nail-biting finish.

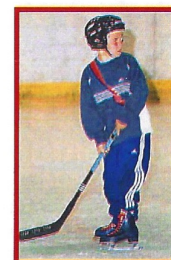
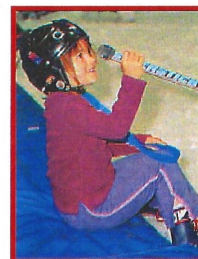
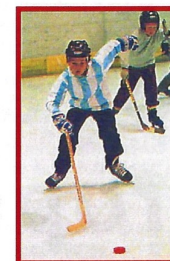

Our main priority at this moment in time is to establish an efficient and viable club, so that we can help the MK Lightning through it's inaugural season and provide a good, solid supporters club base. 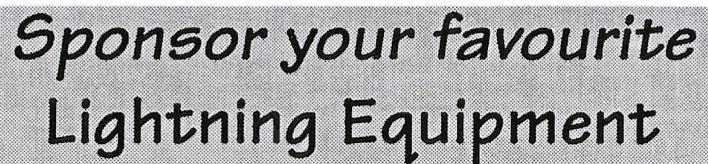

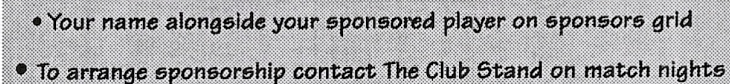

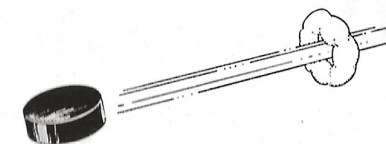

OFFICIAL REFEREE'S SIGNALS



BOARDING
Pound closed fist into open palm of other hand. *Forcing a player into the boards.*



DELAYED PENALTY
Extends arm upwards and points to penalized player. *Penalty called after penalized team gains possession of puck.*



HOLDING
Clasp wrist of the whistle hand with the opposite hand. *Holding an opponent with hands or stick.*



CHARGING
Rotating clenched fists around each other. *A player who runs, jumps or charges an opponent.*



ELBOWS
Taps elbow of the whistle hand with other hand. *Using elbows in any way to foul an opponent.*



HOOKEING
Tugging motion with both hands towards chest. *Impeding an opponents progress by hooking with a stick.*



CROSS-CHECKING
A forward and backward motion with both fists. *Cross-checking on opponent with the shaft of the stick.*



HIGH STICKS
Hold both fists clenched one above the other and above head. *Carrying or using stick above shoulder level.*



SLASHING
Chopping motion with one hand over the other. *Impeding progress of an opponent by slashing with a stick.*



INTERFERENCE
Crossed arms in front of the chest. *Impeding progress of an opponent not in possession of the puck.*



ROUGHING
Extends right arm from side with thrust. *Unnecessary roughness on an opponent.*



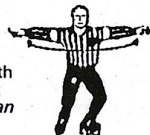
TRIPPING
Strike right leg with right hand below the knee. *Tripping an opponent with stick, knee, foot, arm or elbow.*



MISCONDUCT
Both hands on hips. *Continued misconduct after warning.*



SPEARING
Jabbing motion with both hands in front of body. *Spearling an opponent with the stick blade, or attempting to.*



WASH OUT
Both arms swing laterally across body palms down. *Goal disallowed or no offside after delay call.*



TIME-OUT
Use both hands to form a T in front of the chest.



ICING
Linesman's arms folded across the upper chest.



KNEEING
Slapped the knee with palm of hand. *Called when using knee to impede opponent.*
